

Fishing Regulations for Rauschelesee and Upper Spintikteich

1. This permit is only valid in conjunction with the official fishing license and is non-transferable.
2. The catch limit for pike is 1 fish, zander 1 fish, and carp 1 fish per day. Carp over 5 kilograms must be released.
3. A maximum of 2 fishing rods may be used simultaneously. The fisherman must always be present at his rods.
4. All fishing gear, such as nets, traps, night lines, etc., are PROHIBITED except for the fishing rod.
5. All license holders are reminded to report any observed violations of legal and internal regulations to the nearest supervisory authority or the municipal office. This also applies to water pollution and the occurrence of fish diseases (fish kills).
6. The license holder must immediately record every caught fish in the catch list with a pen (species, length, weight).
7. Fishing is only allowed at the declared fishing spots.
8. Fishing at the municipal beach is prohibited from May 15 to September 30.
9. During the closed season, and for fish caught under the minimum size, they must be released back into the lake immediately and gently. If a hook is deeply swallowed, the fishing line must be cut before or in the fish's mouth, and the fish should be carefully released.
10. Fish that are no longer viable must be cut up and thrown into the water as food. Sick fish must be removed from the lake regardless of closed season or minimum size.
11. The retention of fish that must be released is prohibited.
12. The use of live vertebrates as bait is prohibited. Dead bait fish may only be used with a single hook.
13. Fish from other waters may not be used as bait in Rauschelesee and Spintikteich.
14. The supervisory fisherman must be presented with the permit and the catch list during inspections and, upon request, the caught fish for verification.
15. The supervisory fisherman must be followed in all fishing-related matters, regardless of any subsequent legal complaint rights.
16. It is the duty of all anglers to behave collegially and helpfully while practicing sport fishing, keep the fishing spot clean, and leave no waste behind. Open fires are strictly prohibited.
17. The municipality of Keutschach am See asks you, as a conscientious fisherman, to keep the catch list diligently in the interest of the fish population (species development, biological balance).
18. When renewing the permit, the expired permit with the catch list must be submitted (at GH "Maria," owner Manuela Okorn, or the municipal office).
19. In addition to the legal provisions, the fishing regulations also apply. Violating these regulations results in the immediate, uncompensated revocation of the permit.
20. The use of treble and double hooks is generally prohibited (except for lures like spinners or wobblers).
21. Fishing and deploying drones is strictly prohibited.
22. Fishing with boats is not allowed at Spintikteich. Boats are only allowed on Rauschelesee with written permission. Self-provided inflatable boats may be used. Electric motors are prohibited.
23. Fishing and boating are prohibited in designated protected areas.
24. Fishing from and with Stand-up Paddleboards (SUP) is not allowed!
25. Only baits suitable for fishing may be used. Dog food like Frolic, etc., is strictly prohibited.
26. Fishing without a mat is not allowed and will result in the revocation of the permit. All caught fish must be handled on a mat.
27. For carp fishing, appropriately sized nets must be used (min. 100 cm).
28. Caught fish (carp) may only be kept in adequately sized carp sacks (individually) in deep water.
29. The catch list (which must always be kept up to date) must be fully completed by the fishermen (including released fish such as carp, undersized pike, zander, etc.) and submitted to the municipal office of Keutschach am See by October 31 (either in the municipal mailbox or by email to: info@keutschach.at).

30. The gutting and scaling of fish at the water is prohibited.
 31. Feeding fish (carp) is allowed with a maximum of 0.5 kg per fishing day.
 32. Fishing is only allowed within casting distance.
 33. Deviations from the aforementioned regulations will be announced separately and appropriately.
- Failure to observe the above regulations will lead to the immediate revocation of the fishing permit.
